If your little girl is turning 4, here is a good one that rhymes with her birthday age!

Ballerina

For an all-girls' party, a ballet party theme would be a lovely idea.

For a success ballerina party you'll need to have a fabulous party invitation with witty, sweet and thoughtful wordings.
